Take Route 539 South - towards shore
Make Left onto Route 530 East - towards
Whiting

At light for Lacey Road make Right
Follow Lacey Road all the way to Route 9 S
Make Right onto Route 9 South

Travel approximately 4 miles look for
"NYC Pizza" and "Cappy's Irish Pub"
Turn Left onto Lighthouse Drive (the road is
right before the restaurant)

Travel approximately 1 mile
Turn right onto Tiller Drive
Once in the Marina go straight
Look for slip B 14

Cancellations on charters must be made at least 2 weeks prior to scheduled trip. If not, there will be no refund on your deposit.

We have a zero tolerance policy on illegal drugs. If they are found on board the trip we will return to dock and the U.S. Coast Guard will be notified. NO REFUNDS will be given.

Alcohol is permitted but in moderation. No hard liquor.

No glass bottles are allowed only cans or plastic bottles.

Each person will be responsible for the food and drink for the day. Please limit the number of coolers brought on board the boat.

\$100.00 dollars will be charged if rod and reel are lost overboard.

Not responsible for articles left on board.

No firearms or knives allowed on board.

A 30% deposit is REQUIRED on all trips. The balance is due in cash before leaving the dock.
